- Service
- Worship
- Resources

This will involve looking at your current practice and commitments, and deciding prayerfully, in the light of all God has done for us, what return we wish to make.

The extra element in this process, is finding someone we are willing to trust with this information, someone we are willing to hold us accountable. This does not need to be someone from St Barnabas. There will be a temptation to avoid this last commitment. Please resist it!
